

PRRD Report
August 25, 2016

R2: After some uncertainty, it was concluded that the Alternate on the Solid Waste Committee does not need to be an Alternate Director.

R3: A recycling contract in the amount of 1.5 million per year (based on volume) for five years was awarded to R-3 Recycle-it Resource Recovery.

R7: An amendment to the Charlie Lake sewer bylaw to prohibit dumping of sewerage that originates in a parcel other than the parcel from which the waste is discharged into the public sewer was passed.

R11: The Peace River Regional District (PRRD) will be hosting a public meeting in Chetwynd, date to be announced, to report on the Water Quality Study just completed by GW Solutions. See information package for recommendations approved by the PRRD Board.
