

Spotlight: Changes to bridge increase foot and bicycle traffic

To meet their sustainable transportation goals, the City of Vancouver, BC, had to accommodate significantly more pedestrians and cyclists on one of the city's busiest bridges. After many studies and community consultations, the city added separate sidewalks and bike lanes on the Burrard Bridge in both directions, making active transportation safer and more practical.

This initiative, supported by funding from FCM's Green Municipal Fund (GMF), allows residents to safely walk or bike across the heavily-trafficked bridge, which is a vital link between downtown and residential neighbourhoods.


