Re: Gwillim Lake Provincial Park

This letter is being written at the request of Council to express the concerns relative to the Gwillim Lake Provincial Park situated approximately 37 kms from the town of Tumbler Ridge.

The area of concern at the Gwillim Lake Provincial Park is around the dock area of the boat launch. The dock isn't anchored properly which in turn is causing the dock to float around creating an issue of safety for boaters and other users of the boat launch. The District is requesting that the dock area around the boat launch is upgraded to rectify the situation and to mitigate any potential safety hazards.
